

I-Net Bridge – Privacy Policy

We respect and are committed to protecting your privacy. We promise that we will take steps to use your personal information only in ways that are compatible with this privacy policy. The following policies are in effect for the web pages, newsletters, applications owned and operated by I-Net Bridge.

What information are you collecting and how are you collecting it?

Every computer connected to the internet is given a domain name and a set of numbers that serve as that computer's IP address. When a visitor requests a page from any website within the I-Net Bridge network, our web servers automatically recognise that visitor's domain name and IP address. The domain name and IP address reveal nothing other than the IP address form which you have accessed our site. We use this information to examine our traffic in aggregate, but do not collect and evaluate this information for individuals. Our web servers do not record visitors' e-mail addresses.

What are cookies?

From time to time I-Net Bridge or its advertisers may send a "cookie" to your computer. A cookie is a small piece of data that is sent to your browser from a web server and stored on your computer's hard drive. A cookie can't read data from your hard disk or read cookie files created by other site. Cookies do not damage your system. We use cookies to identify which areas of I-Net Bridge's network you have visited, so next time you visit those pages are readily accessible. You can choose whether to accept cookies by changing the settings of your browser. You can reset your browser to refuse all cookies, or allow your browser to show you when a cookie is being sent. If you choose not to accept these cookies, your experience at our site and other websites may be diminished and some features may not work as intended.

What other information do you request?

We may request your e-mail address for the purpose of conducting a survey or to provide additional services (for example, subscriptions and to receive e-mail newsletters). We maintain a strict "no-spam" policy – we will not give your e-mail address to a third party without your consent.

In addition, I-Net Bridge will not send you e-mail that you have not agreed to receive. We may from time to time send e-mail announcing new I-Net Bridge products and services.

When you enter a contest or other promotion, we may ask for your name, address, and e-mail address so we can administer the contest and notify winners. Wherever I-Net Bridge collects information we make an effort to include a link to this privacy policy on that page.

Will you disclose the information you collect to outside third parties?

I-Net Bridge will disclose personal information when required by law or in good-faith belief that such action is necessary to:

1. Conform to the edicts of the law or comply with a legal process served on I-Net Bridge;
2. Protect and defend the rights or property of the I-Net Bridge network of sites;
3. Identify people who may be violating the law, the legal notice, or the rights of third parties; and
4. To co-operate with the investigation of purported unlawful activities.

I-Net Bridge uses reasonable precautions to keep the information disclosed to us secure. Furthermore, we are not responsible for any breach of security or the actions of any third parties that receive the information. I-Net Bridge also links to a wide variety of other sites. We are not responsible for their privacy policies or how they treat information about their users.

What else should I know about my privacy when online?

I-Net Bridge does not share with any of the sites to which it links any of the individual information you provide I-Net Bridge with, although I-Net Bridge may share aggregate data

with such websites, such as how many people use our site. Please check with those sites to determine their privacy policies. Please keep in mind that whenever you voluntarily disclose personal information online – for example through e-mail, discussion lists, or elsewhere – that information can be collected and used by others. In short, if you post personal information online that is accessible to the public, you may receive unsolicited messages from other parties in return. Ultimately, you are solely responsible for maintaining the secrecy of your personal information. Please be careful and responsible whenever you're online.
